We're carrying out improvement work at our Peckforton pumping station...

What are we doing?

You may have noticed an increase in construction traffic over the last few months to and from our pumping station in Peckforton. This is due to groundworks that have been taking place in preparation for the improvement work planned to start towards the end of this year. The improvement works to the site are part of a £12 million water quality project. As part of the groundwork, we plan to remove a number of damaged trees on the site during September 2022. Before this work begins a security/safety fence will be erected around the site.

Regarding the removal of the trees, we have been and will continue to work closely with Cheshire East Council, National Trust and the Forestry Commission. We are also working alongside our ecologists to keep the local wildlife safe.

We would like to engage with the local community with our plans for the site. We will be in contact shortly once we have more information to share with you.

Thank you for bearing with us

We fully appreciate that it can be a pain to have this work happening near you - but please be assured that we will do everything we can to minimise any disruption. Our contractors J A Harrison will use signage and barriers to keep you and the team safe. Footpaths in the woodland will be open for use but please be aware of the working area.
