**Vyrnwy Aqueduct Modernisation Programme – Preparation for our main construction work in 2023**

To help us continually improve the quality of water we supply to customers, we're planning some work relating to our Vyrnwy aqueduct, a section of which runs near to where you live as it continues through to Prescott in Merseyside.

In preparation for starting our main construction work we need to carry out some essential upfront work. This will involve the installation of a temporary access road, preparation of our temporary working areas and delivery of plant and equipment. We will also need to remove some trees and hedgerow within our working areas and have been co-ordinating this work with the landowner and local authority.

**How this may affect you:**

We'll begin this preparation activity in January 2023 and expect it will take three to six weeks to complete at each location.

We will be setting up our working areas in private land with access from the following roads, shown in the area 03 map and access point information on the back of this letter.

Our working hours will be from 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and there will be no weekend working.

There may be an increase in noise and construction traffic whilst we carry out this upfront work, however there will be no impact to business or residential access.

Once set up, our working areas will remain in place ready for the main construction work so there will be periods of time when there is no activity on site. We'll write to you again in advance of starting the main construction phase of work, which we expect to begin from summer next year in area 03.

We understand this type of work can be inconvenient. Our team will do all they can to minimise any disruption for you and the local community and don't worry, your water and wastewater services will not be affected and can be used as normal.

### Community drop in session ahead of our main construction work in 2023

We will be providing further updates to all residents in the local area as this project progresses and will be holding public drop-in sessions where you can meet with and discuss the project with members of our team. We'll write to you again in early 2023 to confirm the locations and dates for the drop in sessions.
